

## **Glenfield College - Year 13 Dress Code**

For your information the following are the requirements of the dress code:

1. All students must have a neat and tidy standard of dress, similar to what would be expected in an office environment.
2. All students must be neatly groomed. In particular, male students must be clean shaven and have hair tied back if it is shoulder length or longer.
3. Dresses, blouses and tops should fully cover the front, back and shoulders of the student.
4. Visible body piercings are prohibited apart from a single pair of earrings.
5. Caps may be worn outdoors, but the peak must face forward.
6. Other school rules concerning student appearance, which the rest of the student body are required to conform to, still apply. In particular these are rules around makeup, hairstyles and jewellery.

Specifically excluded from being worn are the following:

1. Screen printed slogans and illustrations that could cause offence, including sexual material and material promoting liquor or smoking.
2. Fabrics of a transparent or semi-transparent nature.
3. Low cut armholes or necklines
4. Singlets and tank tops.
5. Workboots, slippers, jandals and jandal-style footwear as well as backless shoes or backless sandals.
6. Beach shorts and shorts which are part of a sporting uniform such as running shorts, basketball shorts etc.
7. Beanies and any other headware apart from caps.
8. Outfits which are almost entirely black.
9. Dresses and shorts which do not reach mid-thigh level.
10. Visible tattoos which may cause offence.

Where there is any dispute over the dress code, the matter is referred to the Principal whose judgement is final.

From now on, students who breach the code or wear items which are specifically excluded will be sent home to change and warned that the privilege of being allowed not to wear uniform may be withdrawn if there is another breach of the code. To avoid this happening we would ask you to remind your son/daughter about dressing sensibly for school.
